
George & Lenny

Sometimes George & Lenny want to be alone and sometimes they want to be together. This is the central theme of 'George & Lenny' but can be a tricky concept for our children to understand. Talking about a book can be a great way to help children to explore the themes with an adult acting as an interested listener. Here are some sentence openers to help generate that

discussion:

Lenny wonders what George is doing when he is alone and realises that he misses his friend. He draws a portrait of George.




Why not draw a portrait of one of your friends. Have you included all their features?




