It could be a show you have seen at the theatre or a show you have watched on TV. Remember, a review should describe the show without giving too much information away. You could express your opinion about what you enjoyed but also what you did not enjoy so much.






Discussion - At the end of the story, Bear must go to sleep in his cave? Do you know why? This is called hibernation. Which other animals do you know which sleep during the winter months?
