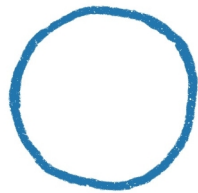


Learn how to draw Whisper the Dragon!

You will need:

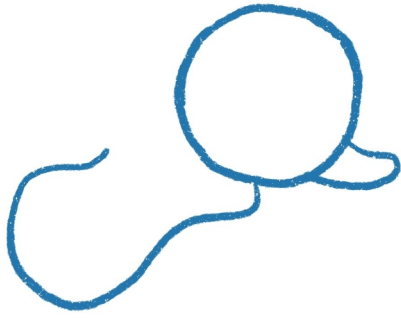
- A sheet of paper or sketchbook page
- A graphite pencil
- A black pen
- Some colouring pencils/pens/paints



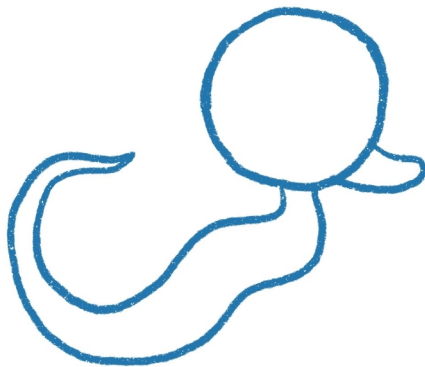
1. Start with your graphite pencil, and draw a circle slightly to the right and up from the centre of your page. This will be Whisper's head! it does not have to be a perfect circle.



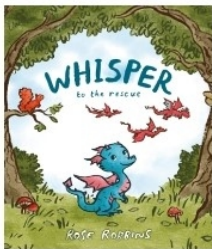
2. Add a little nose to the bottom right of the circle (a bit like a duckbill but shorter).



3. Draw a line sloping down, then to the left, then gently down and swoop up and around, with a flick at the end.



4. Draw another line, following the other but widening out, in order to make a body and tail.



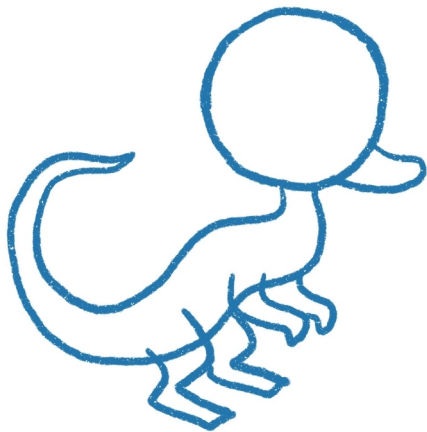

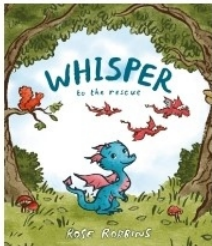




5. Draw four soft zig-zags coming out of the bottom of the body-shape. The top two are arms and are shaped like S's, while the bottom two are legs and shaped like Z's.



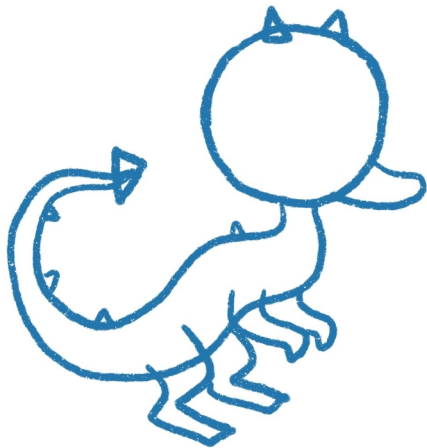
6. Draw an additional line for each arm and leg, filling them out.

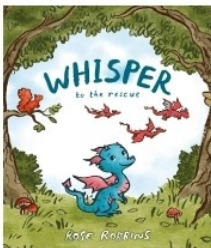




7. Draw six little triangles for Whisper's horns, spikes, and at the end of his tail.



8. Add Whisper's ears and wings. These are bat-wing shaped, with three spikes.

9. Now you have the basic shapes and frames down, you can draw over the top in pen, adding details like eyes, nostrils, mouth, fingers and toes!



10. To finish him off, colour Whisper with a green/blue body, and pink ears and wings! Or you could choose your own colours.
